celebrates 50 years

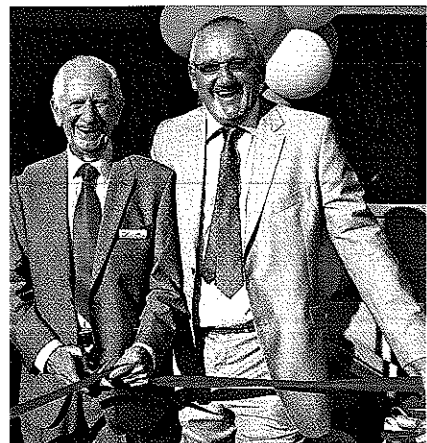
